MINUTES SPICEBUSH AT SEAPINES OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC 2016 ANNUAL MEETING

David Shay thanked everyone as his term on the board was ending.

The board then took some questions from those present and responded. One of the questions related to a member giving their week to a military R&R charity when they can't use it. The board said that any way that the owner wants to use their week is okay, they simply need to let Reservations know so they can follow up.

The board thanked Dave Shay for six years of service.
